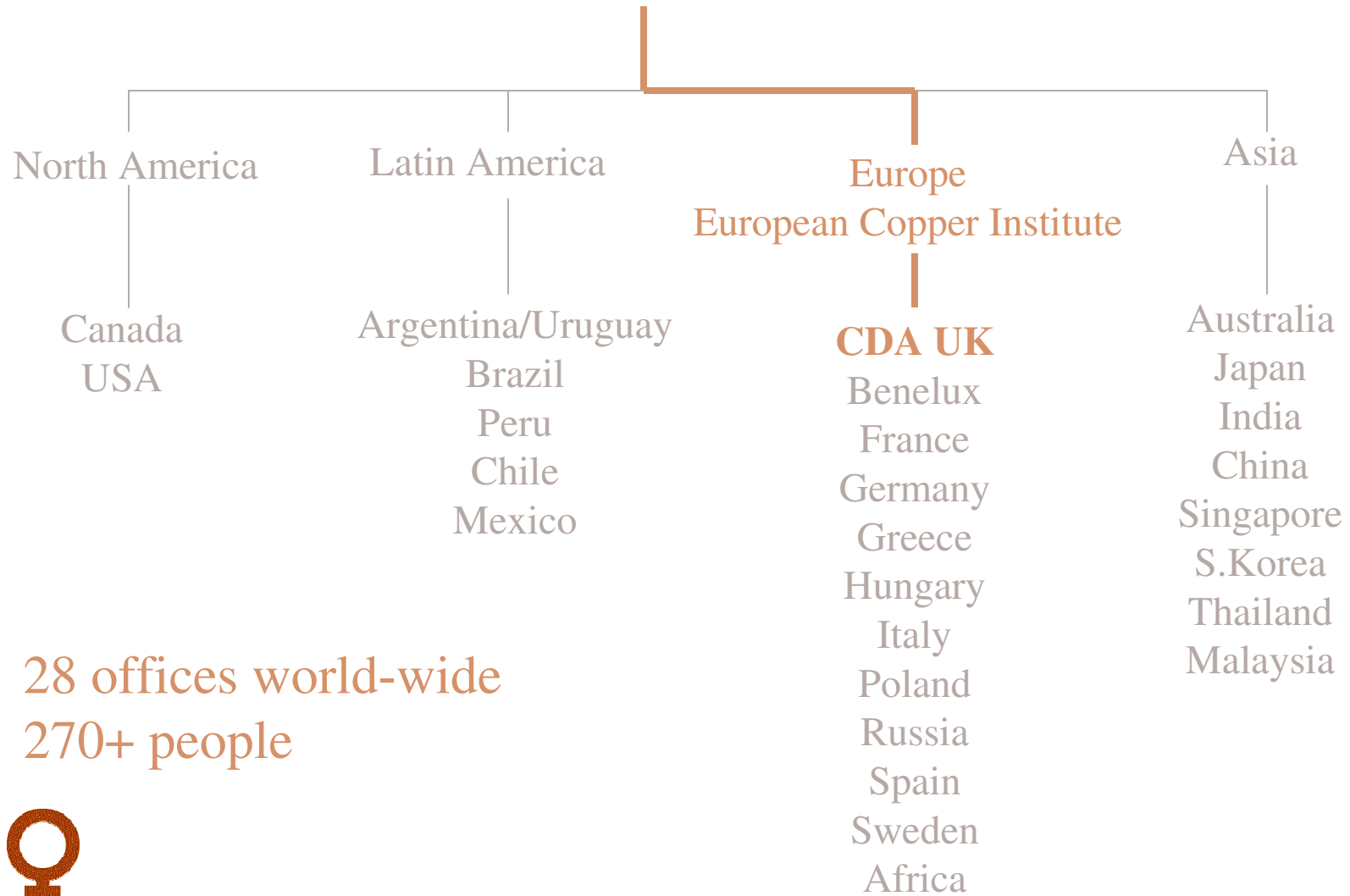

Function & Funding

- International Copper Association (ICA)
 - funded by copper producers and fabricators
 - sets strategy globally
 - allocates funding to programmes/regions
- European Copper Institute (ECI)
 - funded by ICA and European fabricators
 - co-ordinates European Programmes
 - carries out Regional Programmes e.g. Health & Environment
 - allocates European funding to projects/countries
- Copper Development Association (CDA)
 - implements programmes at national level with local members/partners
 - participates in programmes at European/global level
 - funded by ICA/ECI and local members/partners

Copper Development Association UK - Membership

- What can CDA offer its members?
 - Membership of CDA provides the opportunity for companies to define and participate in market development activities in the UK. The aim is to grow/defend markets rather than the market share of individual members. Members can benefit from:
 - Steering of/participation in market development programmes
 - Information from the global copper network
 - Industry forums
 - Technical expertise
 - Impartiality, neutrality, credibility
 - Established reputation - 75 years



Copper Development Association UK - Membership

- Who is eligible for membership?
 - Membership of the Association is open to companies:
 - mining, smelting, producing or refining copper
 - manufacturing, fabricating or distributing copper
 - otherwise connected with or interested in copper and/or copper-containing materials.
 - Three groups of members are recognised for membership fee purposes:
 - smelters/refiners
 - semi-fabricators
 - other industrial companies



Copper Development Association UK - Membership

- *Refiner / Smelter:*
 - Given the nature of the sales coverage, membership in this category is anticipated only at European level. For any company in this category wishing to be a local CDA member only, the ECI membership fee will apply, with the funds paid directly to that CDA only.
 - Cash fee covers all national promotion and communications activities, all ECI environment & health and regulatory affairs activities and makes a contribution to the fixed, network operating costs of the CDA. Work in kind contributions will still be expected, as today, in promotion projects.



Copper Development Association UK - Membership

- *Semi-fabricator:*
 - Cash fee covers all national promotion and communications activities, all European and national environment and health and regulatory affairs activities and makes a contribution to the fixed, network operating costs of the CDA. Work in kind contributions will still be expected in promotion projects.
 - Production is defined as output of semi-fabricated copper and copper alloys (excluding wire rod and wire and cable products). The consolidation of group tonnages, to avoid double counting, and allocation of fees to business units or operating subsidiaries are the responsibility of the Member Company. Production multiplier will be the average of the last three known calendar years, e.g. for 2010 it will be $(2006 + 2007 + 2008)/3$.



Copper Development Association UK - Membership

- *Other Industrial Companies:*
 - Cash fee covers all European and local environment & health, regulatory affairs and communications activities, with the exception of the European voluntary risk assessment (where a special fee is required), and makes a contribution to the fixed, network operating costs of the CDA. In addition, membership allows the company to participate, either by cash co-funding or by work in kind, in any promotion project of that CDA.
 - Cash fee is linked to annual turnover (T), in millions of euro, of the relevant copper business unit. This will include wire rod and wire and cable producers.

- The 2010 membership fees are as follows:

(payable in £ at the rate of exchange prevailing at the time of joining):

Semi-Fabricator	P >20,000	0.56 €/MET pa
	P=10,000 to 20,000	11,130 €
	P<10,000	5,590 €

(P is the average production for the years 2006, 2007 and 2008)

	Annual turnover	Annual fee €
Other Industrial Companies	T > 10M€/yr	5,590 €
	T < 10M€/yr	2,795 €

(T is the average turnover of the last three known years)
